



Notice of Activity

Shell Canada will undertake a planned shutdown of its Caroline plant and field in May and June of 2018. This turnaround is required to meet regulatory inspection requirements which necessitates shutting down the facility. During the shut down additional repairs, inspection and maintenance servicing work will occur.

The Shell Caroline Plant and Field Turnaround/Shutdown is planned to begin on May 22, 2018, and will last an estimated 26 days. Approximately 150 additional workers will be on site, divided into two 12-hour shifts.

What the community will see:

- Additional traffic in the area. Please report to Shell Community Affairs any contractor or Shell employee seen driving in an unsafe manner.
- Intermittent flaring over a 24-hour period on May 22/23 as the equipment at the plant is purged with sweet gas and shut down.
- Small amount of flaring on June 16/17 as plant operations are resumed. Dates may vary slightly.
- Small amount of flaring at each of the field compressor stations as the field is shut down.
 - May 17, South Compressor Station next to BP Amoco James River Plant.
 - May 20, Central Compressor Station north of James River Bridge Store.
- Increased activity throughout the field with equipment on site including heavy trucks and additional manpower.

Please note all dates may vary slightly.
